## Wade McCree, Jr. Scholarship Fund

The late Judge Wade McCree, Jr. was one of the founders of Friends School in Detroit. In the early 1960s, when his daughter was refused admission to a local private school because of her race, Judge McCree joined with prominent business leaders in urging the Society of Friends (Quakers) to open a school in Detroit where all children are welcome. Since 1965 Friends School in Detroit has been providing children of Metropolitan Detroit an education stressing academic excellence, creative problem solving, and respect for individuals and community. Our scholarship fund honors the spirit of Judge McCree who, as a federal judge and Solicitor General of the United States, was a mentor to many young people in Detroit.

The scholarships awarded from the Wade McCree, Jr. Scholarship Fund guarantee that Friends School in Detroit remains one of the least expensive and certainly the most economically and racially diverse independent schools in Southeast Michigan. Approximately forty percent of students at Friends School in Detroit receive some type of scholarship, an unprecedented number for an independent school.
